MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

AT TIME OF APPLICATION:

- Minimum age of 21 years old at the time of application
- Minimum of 18 college units
- Valid driver's license (valid California license required upon appointment)
- Weight - proportionate to height
- Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) or Biddle Physical Agility Test Certificate required a time of application (CPAT or Biddle certificate must be dated no later than 18 months from date of application).

AT TIME OF APPLICATION THE FOLLOWING IS REQUIRED:

- Current California EMT certification or National Registry EMT certification at the time of application (California Paramedic license or National Registry Paramedic certification accepted).
 - Applicant must be certified as an EMT in California or licensed as a Paramedic in California at time of appointment, AND,
 - Applicant must have a current BLS Health Care Provider card at time of appointment.

CALIFORNIA APPLICANTS:

At the time of application at least one the following is required:

- California Firefighter academy graduation certificate holder within two years of application date; (For academy graduates that do not possess a California State Fire Fighter 1&2 certification, the California State Fire Fighter 1&2 certification must be obtained within 18 months from time of appointment).

OR

- California State Certified Firefighter 1

OUT OF STATE APPLICANTS OR DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE:

- Full-Time Professional Firefighter with a minimum of six months experience, post-training academy at the time of application date.

AND

- An IFSAC and/or Pro Board accredited state or Department of Defense certification that includes Fire Fighter 1 and Hazardous Materials Awareness and Operations. IFSAC and/or Pro Board accredited certification for Wildland Fire Fighter 1 not required, but desirable. (For out of state applicants that do not possess a California State Fire Fighter 1&2 certification, the California State Fire Fighter 1&2 certification must be obtained within 18 months from time of appointment).

PLEASE NOTE: Per the Beverly Hills Fire Department's policy, tattoos and/or body piercing shall not be visible when on duty wearing short sleeve station uniform.

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MAJOR DUTIES

- Responds to all types of rescue, fire suppression, medical and non-medical emergency calls and implements action required to save lives and property.
- Participates in continuing study, training and drill activity to achieve and maintain required skills to include regular fitness program to maintain good health and physical strength.
- Maintains fire equipment, ambulance, apparatus, hydrants, quarters and grounds to include performing motor tests on apparatus when assigned as a Fire Engineer.
- Prepares and maintains various departmental reports and forms and operates departmental computer.
- Provides life support, CPR and first aid and assists paramedics when necessary.
- Shops for and prepares meals.
- Operates the tiller steering wheel on the fire truck when responding to emergency calls.
- Performs hazardous material containment practices.
- Ventilates burning buildings to carry off hazardous smoke and gases.
- Performs fire and arson investigation to include examining fire scene and determining origin or cause of fire.
- Performs fire prevention inspections and tests to assure compliance with state and federal laws, rules and regulations.
- Conducts public education and information classes to include performing public appearances and conducting fire station tours.
- Senior firefighters may supervise junior firefighters during high rise firefighting operations

and hazardous material containment.

- May serve as alarm operator (dispatcher) or drive ambulance when necessary.
- May serve as Captain or Engineer in their absence.
- Performs other related work as required.

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KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES

ABILITY TO:

- Pass a job-related psychological evaluation and medical examination
- Meet all physical requirements that would enable a candidate to perform the major duties outlined above.

KNOWLEDGE OF:

- Departmental rules and regulations on fire prevention, safety, fire codes, first aid and rescue methods to include state laws, municipal codes and ordinances related to fire prevention and inspection work.
- Emergency rescue and evaluation procedures involving fire, chemicals or bomb threats.
- Firefighting principles, techniques and principles of hydraulics applied to fire suppression.
- Modern fire prevention and suppression methods, fire behavior and basic fire chemistry.
- State and local building and maintenance codes and the health and safety code.
- Fire protection and fire alarm systems and components and their functional requirements.
- Knowledge of Beverly Hills geography, streets and area hospitals.

WORKING KNOWLEDGE OF:

- Vehicle mechanics and rescue procedures involving electricity and gas.
- Knowledge of Beverly Hills geography, streets and area hospitals.

SKILL IN:

- Performing strenuous work under adverse conditions for a sustained period of time to include ability to react quickly and calmly in emergency situations.
- Operating and maintaining fire equipment, apparatus and a variety of tools.
- Inspection and testing fire protection and alarm skills.
- Interpreting and enforcing laws, ordinances, statutes and Fire Prevention Bureau requirements.
- Inspecting commercial and residential occupancies and reviewing plans and specifications for fire and life safety code compliance.
- Performing fire and arson investigations to determine cause and origin of fire.
- Driving an ambulance safely during emergencies and in route to an area hospital.
- Thinking clearly, making decisions and reacting quickly in emergency situations.
